Polkadots: The Cool Kids Musical follows Lily Polkadot who just moved to the "Squares Only" town of Rockaway. As the first Polkadot in an all Square school, Lily faces an almost impossible task of gaining acceptance from her peers. Lily's quest seems hopeless until she meets Sky, a Square boy whose curiosity for her unique polkadot skin blooms into a pal-ship. Inspired by the events of The Little Rock 9, Polkadots is a colorful history lesson for children, reminding them that our individual differences make us awesome.

*Sensory friendly performances are designed to accommodate those with sensory dysfunction or sensory processing disorder including those on the autism spectrum, suffering from ptsd, and more. At a sensory friendly performance: house lights are kept partially on; volume is turned down; sound and lighting elements that may be jarring are eliminated; electronic devices such as iPads are allowed; audiences members can come and go if needed; a safe space is created in the lobby for those who do have to exit the theatre; figit toys are welcomed; a show guide is provided to prepare audience members for their visit.
